TOUR SUMMARY

This trip was similar to the Tropical Birding Eastern Australia “top to bottom” itinerary, but designed to be more relaxed. Despite its chilled-out nature, this trip covered a lot of ground and different habitats, from lowland rainforest to eucalyptus savanna, and from Daintree, in the far northeast, south to Tasmania, in the extreme southeast of Australia’s vastness. Though this was officially a birding trip, mammals were certainly some of the top highlights. Chief among these were Duck-billed Platypus, Short-beaked Echidna, Striped Possum, and Koala. Who doesn’t want to see these incredible animals?! True bucket list material. Of course these marquee beasts had lots of support from a range of kangaroos and wallabies. The birds were incredibly diverse, and included almost too many highlights to mention. There were multiple Northern Cassowaries on the road at Daintree, Chowchilla and Australian Logrunner in the rainforest understory, loads of

colorful and tame parrots at O'Reilly's (such as the Crimson Rosella shown on the first page), and a sweet set of Tasmania endemics. This was a great group, and everybody had a great time, enjoying good camaraderie, and lots of jovial meals at local pubs and even some excellent Asian restaurants. There wasn't much not to like about this trip, which left all of us eager to return to Australia for more of what this vast country / continent has to offer.
